Hope Returns

The Iraqi invasion of Kuwait

The series tackles the period during the Iraqi invasion to Kuwait, and the political, economic, and social ramifications of that invasion which reflected negatively on the expats who came back to Jordan, represented by what Mustafa and his wife face at work and in life.

Summary

Mustafa and his wife Rula are forced to leave back to Jordan from Kuwait which was invaded by the Iraqis. On the way, they find an infant girl who survived an accident with her family, so the couple find themselves forced to pretend she is their daughter, despite their desperate attempts to find her family, so they take her in as their daughter to live with their family until her real father appears and the events unfold and things get more complicated until Amal turns 21. During that time, Mustafa works as the manager of the water company owned by his father, which faces problems by some people who profited from the war, so the family has to sell the company.

Dramatic Plot

The series takes place in the 1990s, during the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait, and the ramifications of that event which affected the whole region politically, economically, and socially. The series tackles those events and their effects and projections on its characters who interact with the political changes despite the social theme of the series. That impact lasted since the Iraqi invasion of Kuwait and the events in Palestine starting 1991 until 2011, as well as the public protests demanding change, the fall of Ben Ali's regime and then the fall of Mubarak's regime. Arab actors from Egypt and Iraq appear in the show in accordance with the script's requirements.

Production Value

This series was filmed with the latest equipment and devices that not only introduce the concept of portable cameras, but also represent the cinematic formula of visual formation. The costume and accessories design were unlike anything done before in social drama series.

Language

Several Arabic dialects, depending on the characters (Jordanian, Egyptian, Iraqi)
