Investigator Sameer and Interpol man Zaid fail to obtain a result from the investigation with the camp's residents about smuggling girls. Karim is threatened because of the events and of Siba press investigation about human trafficking. So, Adham gives orders to kill Azzam, tracks the association's activity and visits Nada to cause the association to be closed first; then, he makes himself the reason for burning it so the refugee Sarah would die during that. Tariq, son of Nada, gets addicted to drugs after learning the secret of his mother's cancer, and Jarir continues his war against Saleem, and Salma supports Saleem's against him, but he loses and resorts to seeking support from a suspicious rich man, David, who is the only solution to save his company.

## Drama/ Modern/ Humanitarian/ Action

Detective Sameer and Interpol officer Zaid try to track down the gang in the camp, but it all goes in vain. Zaid follows Noura and discovers that she was his sweetheart when they were teens, yet he does not know that she is Karim's wife. Karim suspects Zaid, so he imprisons Noura and injures her. After Sarah escapes from the gang, and Qamar survives as a witness, Karim is threatened and decides to kill Azzam. He also holds grudges against the association that supports Sarah and Qamar, especially after Siba making a press report on the smuggling of female refugees. Meanwhile, Tarek falls in love with a girl named Hala, without knowing that she is of unknown parentage. Hala gets to know Adham and Karim later, and works for them but then she regrets doing so and backs down.

Saleem faces a failure of his mercantile business due to bribes offered by Jarir to destroy him, but Salma foils Jarir's plans. Later, it is revealed that she is his ex-wife, whom he abandoned for being paralyzed. We see Siba falling in love with a young man, Yazan, who spends a lot of time with her. He is Nada's son from her first marriage, but he hides this fact from everyone. The doctor tells Nada that she has cancer, but she keeps the news a secret from everyone except for her friend Wafaa. Karim had already planned to take advantage of the association and get to know Nada, and then he causes it to close temporarily after informing the police that it had refugee women who did not have labor permit and a permission to reside.

The police, headed by Sameer and Zaid, investigate Qamar and Sarah, and get information about Karim and his men. Zaid continues to monitor them. At the same time, Noura tries to commit suicide, so Karim is obliged to take her to the hospital where she meets Wafaa and her husband, Dr. Jawad, by coincidence. She joins the association which leads Karim to burning it as a payback. Sarah dies, and Nada and the girlfriends are shocked, but they open a new headquarters, and Tariq is now addicted to drugs. Meanwhile, Jarir loses a lot of money. So, rich David offers saving his company in exchange for marrying Jarir to his daughter. Amid these events, Nada falls down while she's with her family.
