This series tells the story of the British Orientalist Robert Newman, who is caught by Sheikh Jad'an's men, so he claims that he was there to buy Arabian horses, but Sheikh Jad'an's realizes his real intentions and stops him without doing him harm, so Newman admires the Sheikh and lives with the tribe, writing down their customs, traditions, and the details of their daily life He acquires Their habits and took part in their battles and quests for revenge, and witnesses love stories and years of drought. As for Raddad who was rescued by the girl "Ghazala" from road robbers, they were bonded by a love story that ended with their marriage after years of waiting and yearning. The series also tells many love and heroic stories that are immortalized in the memory of the desert.

Dramatic Treatment

The Bedouins derive from their heritage and traditions the values they need to put their life in order in a tough environment like the desert. These are values they hold dear and take pride in. The series highlights some of these values, such as Bedouin hospitality and the special treatment offered to guests, as they offer them protection and avenge them against their enemies.

This series was filmed with the latest equipment and devices that not only introduce the concept of portable cameras, but also represent the cinematic formula of visual formation. The costume and accessories design were unlike anything done before in Bedouin drama series.
